Location: The Sycamore Springs Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF) is located in Jefferson County, Missouri approximately 30 miles southwest of St. Louis along Heads Creek, a tributary to the Big River.

Description: There is erosion occurring along Heads Creek, just upstream of the confluence with an unnamed stream, which is impacting the northwest corner of the treatment plant.

Status: St. Louis District is anticipating Federal Interest Determination (FID) approval in September 2023.

Importance: With project and funding, bank protection would be implemented to protect public infrastructure that provides essential public services from flood and storm damages due to erosion.

Authority: Section 14 of Flood Control Act of 1946 (PL 79-526), as amended.

Schedule:
