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# Information Paper Sycamore Springs Wastewater Treatment Facility, MO

## Feasibility (CAP Section 14)

#### Contact:

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**Location:** The Sycamore Springs Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF) is located in Jefferson County, Missouri approximately 30 miles southwest of St. Louis along Heads Creek, a tributary to the Big River.

**Description**: There is erosion occurring along Heads Creek, just upstream of the confluence with an unnamed stream, which is impacting the northwest corner of the treatment plant.

**Status:** The St. Louis District notified non-Federal sponsor of study termination due to negative Federal Interest Determination. Sponsor will provide updated Letters of Intent (LOIs) for Big River and Mirasol WWTFs for reconsideration in FY24.

**Importance:** Without project and federal funding, bank protection would be implemented to protect public infrastructure that provides essential public services from flood and storm damages due to erosion.

**Authority**: Section 14 of Flood Control Act of 1946 (PL 79-526), as amended.
