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Location: Project authority covers water and wastewater infrastructure assistance within the City of St. Louis, Missouri.

Description: The purpose of this authority is to provide water and wastewater infrastructure assistance within the City of St. Louis, Missouri. Focus of segments of work to be completed would be drinking water infrastructure improvement projects.

Status: Water Resources Development Act (WRDA) 2022 included \$45M authorization in Federal funding.

Importance: Operating, managing, and keeping sewers functional as well as reducing overflows is necessary for continued economic development and requirement to protect the health and safety of the public.

Authority: Section 219(f)(55) of WRDA 1992, as amended by Section 8375(a)(348) of WRDA 2022.

Schedule: Pending Funding.

Activities for FY24: If funding is received, work could be accelerated to FY24.

Activities after FY24: \$6,100,000 could be used to complete Letter Report, execute Project Partnership Agreement with City of St. Louis, and construct the Chain of Rocks Water Treatment Plant Shore Intake North Well Rehabilitation Project.
