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Location: This Federal project is located on the right bank of the Mississippi River between river miles 47.5 and 48.8 above the Ohio River in Scott and Cape Girardeau counties.

Description: The project consists of a 1,800-foot slack-water harbor, docking facilities, barge-rail-truck transfers, bagging, warehousing, outdoor storage, and fleeting. Authorized purposes include federal dredging of the approach channel and within the port.

Authority: Section 107 of River and Harbor Act of 1960 (Public Law 86-645).
