Description

Wappapello Lake consists of over 8,400 acres of water, 35,900 acres of public land, and 180 shoreline miles. This lake provides flood control, downstream water quality, recreation (10 major recreation areas managed by Corps and eight major recreation areas managed by others), and fish and wildlife conservation.

Authority

The Overton Act of 1936 and the Flood Control Act of 1944.

Activities for FY25

Above Baseline Specific Work

- Environmental Stewardship: Roadway Repairs (\$200k), Wildlife Management (\$200k), Pest and Boundary Maintenance (\$125k), Update Operations Management Plan (\$220k).
- Recreation: Road Repairs (\$718k), Trail Improvements/Repairs (\$1.3M), Recreation Facility Improvements (\$800k).
