Description

The project consists of an 80.15-mile navigation channel, and 16,000 acres of managed lands. Authorized purposes are navigation, recreation, fish and wildlife management, and habitat restoration.

- Ongoing Work Dredging, Forest Management, and Boundary Maintenance.

- Environmental Stewardship: Boundary Maintenance (\$60k), and Cabin Demolition (\$67k).
- Navigation: River Training Structure (\$6.1M), Dredging (\$650k), and Water Management (\$200k).
