Eagle Bluff Trail

Completely renovated in 2011, this scenic trail offers a prime opportunity to get outdoors and enjoy some of the natural features of Mark Twain Lake. There are two brand new overlooks that offer prime views of the lake and the dam. There is plentiful wildlife to view along the trail. In addition, there are various interpretive signs that offer information about the many plants and animals you are likely to see.

The trail and the overlooks are fully paved concrete, making Eagle Bluff Trail accessible by foot, bicycle, and mobility devices. The slow rolling slopes are ideal for a leisurely experience in the woods. All of these features make this trail accessible for people of all abilities.

At a quarter mile long, the Eagle Bluff Trail is a short walk that can satisfy a desire for a quick nature experience or can be slowly enjoyed, offering unlooked for surprises over several laps or multiple visits. The trail is open from 8am until dusk and is free to use.
