

Welcome to the Catfish Cove Pond & Trails

This universally accessible trail, surrounded by acres of native plant prairie, bursts with seasonal wildflowers and hosts many grassland bird species and busy pollinating insects.

How many different types of habitat can you find as you travel along the trail? Platforms located along the way allow opportunities to fish or view aquatic species of plants and animals. You can see a variety of wildlife along the trail which extends, unpaved, through the nearby woods.
