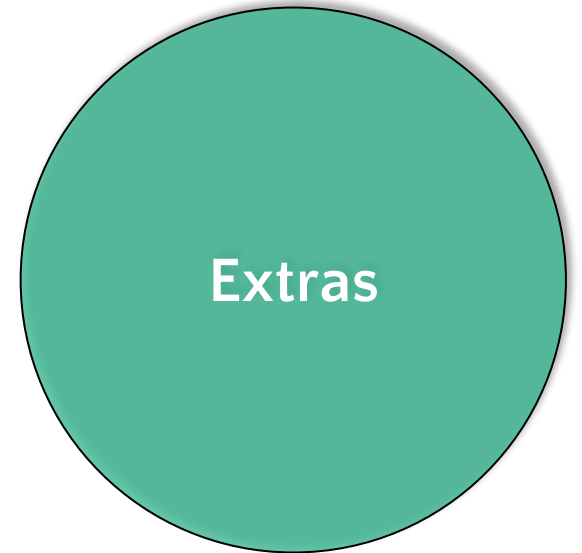
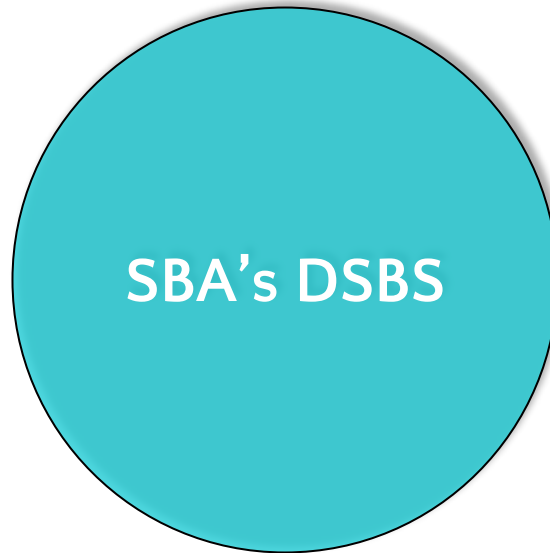
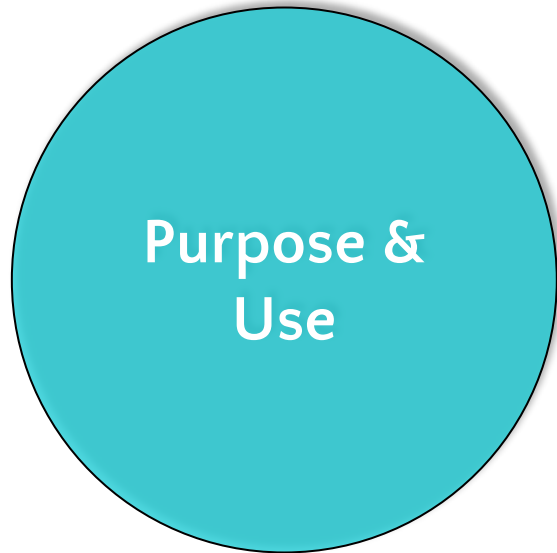

Introduction to NAICS

The North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) is the standard used by Federal statistical agencies in classifying business establishments for the purpose of collecting, analyzing, and publishing statistical data related to the U.S. business economy.

NAICS was developed under the auspices of the Office of Management and Budget (OMB), and adopted in 1997 to replace the [Standard Industrial Classification \(SIC\) system](#). It was developed jointly by the [U.S. Economic Classification Policy Committee \(ECPC\)](#), [Statistics Canada](#), and Mexico's [Instituto Nacional de Estadística y Geografía](#), to allow for a high level of comparability in business statistics among the North American countries.

This official U.S. Government Web site provides the latest information on plans for NAICS revisions, as well as access to various NAICS reference files and tools. Additional information on the background and development of NAICS is available in the [History](#) section of this Web site.

ATTENTION SMALL BUSINESSES: Do you want to further promote your business? The Small Business Administration (SBA) offers a government website called the Dynamic Small Business Search (DSBS). Government contracting/purchasing officials use DSBS in their market research to find viable small businesses for their contracting needs. DSBS collects and provides supplemental information about your company including past work performance, client referrals, and detailed capabilities statements; information that could reduce the selection process time. Federal prime contractors also use the DSBS to find small businesses to include in their subcontracting plans.

Register or Update Your Firm's SBA Profile in the Dynamic Small Business Search (DSBS)

- Who should complete an SBA Profile in the DSBS?
 - REQUIRED: Firms applying for SBA certification as HUBZone, 8(a) Business Development, or 8(a) Joint Venture Program or self-certifying as WOSB or EDWOSB for the WOSB Federal Contracting Program must complete the SBA Supplemental Pages to register or update their SBA Profile.
 - OPTIONAL: We highly recommend all small businesses complete the SBA Supplemental Pages to register or update their SBA Profile.
- How do I complete an SBA Profile in the DSBS?
 - Select Register or Update SBA Profile on this page. This will open a new window and take you directly to the SBA Supplemental Pages for your entity. Please remember to come back to the SAM window to complete and submit your entity registration.
- How do I know if my entity gets an SBA certification?
 - SBA will notify SAM if and when your entity is added to a certification program. SAM will send an e-mail to your entity's administrator when the SBA sends the confirmation.
 - If your entity is added to the 8(a) or 8(a) Joint Venture Program, the Business Type information will be updated. You will be instructed to review the changes found on the General Information page and to re-certify to your entity's small business status.

HELP for Searching the SBSS Database

The SBSS can be used to search for procurement information in multiple ways by using **any** or **all** of the following types of information about the small businesses profiled in the system. **It is not necessary to fill out every part of the form.** You must, however, enter sufficient search criteria to limit the results to 5,000 firms or less, so as not to bog down the system and adversely affect other users.

Businesses can be searched for using any of the following search criteria:

- location (state, congressional district, metropolitan statistical area)
- ownership data (U.S. Citizen owned, minority owned, veteran owned, etc.)
- federal certifications (SBA 8(a) certification)
- industry sector codes (NAICS, "Buy Green" NAICS)
- business type (manufacturing, construction, etc.)
- keywords
- minimum acceptable bonding level(s)
- quality certifications (ISO-9000, etc.)
- security clearance
- EDI capabilities
- unique identifiers (CAGE code, DUNS, EIN, SBA Customer Number, etc.)

Again, **it is not necessary to fill out every part of the form.** But the more criteria you specify in your searches, the more precisely your results will match your needs.

SEARCH SCOPE

First, a definition: "**Criteria Type**" refers to any text entry box, check box, radio button group or drop-down menu, except for the following:

- Ownership and Self-Certifications: All of these check boxes are of the same Criteria Type.
- General Nature of Business: Construction, Manufacturing, Research & Development and Service are all of the same Criteria Type. But "Has TECH-Net Award(s)" is its own Criteria Type, separate from the previous 4.
- Capabilities: The "Exporter?" check box is a different Criteria Type from the "Has an Export Profile in TM OnLine?" check box.
- Quality Assurance Standards: All of these check boxes are of the same Criteria Type.
- The following are not Criteria Types. They are options:
 - the "At least" / "No more than" radio buttons
 - the "Do 'sounds like' matching" / "Do 'first letters' matching" radio buttons
 - the "Maximum number of firms to be displayed at a time" drop-down menu
 - font size
 - the "Format" of the search results (Table, HTML Import or Mail-Merge)

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60-Day Extensions for Entity Registration Renewals During Transition to the New Unique Entity ID

Starting Monday, April 4, 2022, the new Unique Entity ID (generated in SAM.gov) will be the official, governmentwide identifier used for federal awards. To reduce burden during the transition, there will be an automatic, 60-day extension for any existing SAM.gov entity registration needing to renew with an expiration date ranging between March 18, 2022, and April 18, 2022. No action is required on the part of entity registrants.

Each impacted registration renewal will have 60 days added to their expiration date. As an example, an entity registration set to expire on March 18, 2022 will automatically be granted a 60-day extension to May 17, 2022. Entity administrators impacted by this change will receive an email from samadmin@sam.gov with the subject line "60-Day SAM.gov Extension Granted for [Entity Name/DUNS/CAGE]."

The new expiration dates will be included in the SAM entity management extracts and available through web services after the records are extended. We will process the extensions in a deliberate, incremental manner over the course of several weeks and will complete the work by March 3, 2022. This will allow the U.S. government systems which rely on our data to consume it on their normal cadence.
