Before coming to DISA, Ms. Leonard managed the AMC Station Manager contract for 18 countries in Central and South America, ensuring embassy personnel and military members received shipments without incident.

Ms. Leonard began her contracting career with the Air Force Copper Cap Intern Program. She earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Sociology (summa cum laude) from Arizona State University, a Master of Arts degree in Human Relations from the University of Oklahoma, and a Master of Arts degree in Procurement and Acquisition Management from Webster University. Ms. Leonard is DAWAII Level III certified in contracting, holds a CFCM certification from NCMA, and a Small Business Professional Credential from DAU.

- When are they used?
 - Sources Sought Notice is used when you have a defined requirement (ie: recompetes) and you need to determine if there are companies with the capability to do the work
 - **Request for Information** is used when you don't have a defined requirement and you are looking for solutions from industry to help you develop your requirement
- What will they ask for? Skills, capabilities, experience...
- How to respond? Very carefully, thoughtfully, and completely
 - Experience
 - Teaming/JV/subcontracting arrangements
 - Frenemies
