








St. Louis District Mission - Value to the Nation

BIL: \$732M is for the NESP L25 new 1200ft Lock project. NESP, or Navigation and Ecosystem Sustainability Program, is an authorized, multi- purpose program that contains projects across three USACE districts (MVP, MVR, MVS) to get at improved Navigation Efficiency and additional Ecosystem Restoration on the Upper Mississippi and Illinois Rivers. High points of the program include 7 new 1200ft locks at existing facilities. L25 is the first of those new locks to be funded. Look for more information later in this presentation on L25 as we will be awarding an initial construction contract yet this year but will also be looking to engage the construction industry on overall delivery strategy later this year as well.
